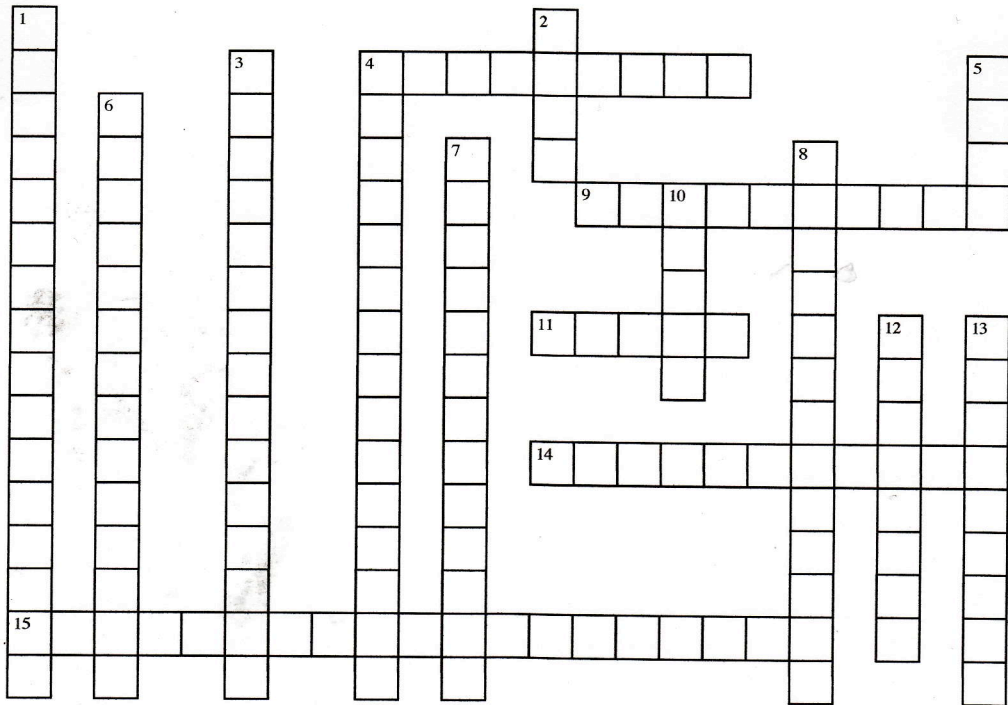


# Take A Healthy Bite Out Of Climate Change Vocabulary

- 15 A type of agriculture that focuses on producing large amounts of food, often using chemical pesticides and fertilizers and heavy machinery (2 words).

- 1 The rise in temperature that happens on Earth because certain gases in the atmosphere trap energy from the sun (2 words).
- 2 Something you can ride instead of a car.
- 3 The amount of carbon dioxide emitted due to the use of fossil fuels by one person or a group (2 words).
- 4 A measurement of concentration. How much of one substance (eg. a pollutant) there is in another substance (eg. a lake) (3 words).
- 5 A fossil fuel made from trees that died long, long ago.
- 6 A way of farming that follows a set of rules that address environmental and animal welfare issues (2 words).
- 7 A substance that contributes to the greenhouse effect by absorbing heat in the atmosphere (2 words).
- 8 Long-term, significant change to the climate conditions of an area or of the earth, usually seen as resulting from human activity (2 words).

- 12 Describes food or something that is brought from a long way away to where it is consumed.
- 13 The distance that food travels on its journey from where it is produced to where it is consumed (2 words).
